- Acceptable mediums include oil, watercolors, acrylic, crayon, pencil, digital etc.
- Only one entry per student is allowed
- Entries are only limited to those residing in the US

The Art Competition is open to students from kindergarten to grade twelve.

- **Division 1:** Grade K to Grade 3
- **Division 2:** Grade 4 to Grade 6
- **Division 3:** Grade 7 to Grade 9
- **Division 4:** Grade 10 to Grade 12

- Two (2) Grand Awards- \$500 each
- Four (4) First Place- \$300 each
- Four (4) Second Place- \$200 each
- Four (4) Third Place- \$100 each
